7. Review and discuss request to measure the sight triangle from Vine Street to Broad Street that was referred by Town Council.
8. Review and discuss a request to determine whether on-street parking can be restricted on Broad Street adjacent to the public alley known as Horseshoe Court that was referred by Town Council.
9. Review and discuss a request for a handicap parking space at 2 Hemlock Circle for Minnie Dickerson.
