

Important Information about your new recycling service.

Dear Borough of Chambersburg resident,

Beginning January 11, 2016, Waste Management will be the new recycling service provider for the Borough of Chambersburg. Recycling benefits the residents of Chambersburg as it not only conserves natural resources, but it also helps reduce the amount of materials sent to the landfill. We're especially excited to announce that the new service will be single-stream recycling – all your recyclables can now go into one cart – no more sorting of materials. Plus recycling will now be collected weekly on the same day as your regular trash pick-up.

There will be a period of transition as the new recycling program takes effect. Please note important dates and service expectations below:

- **JANUARY 11:** Residents may continue to use their existing 18-gallon bins for recycling. You can mix all your recyclables together – sorting is no longer required.
- **FEBRUARY 6 – FEBRUARY 29:** New 32-gallon wheeled carts with lids are available for free as part of the Waste Management single stream recycling service. We ask that residents pick up the new carts at the Borough Utility Service Center, 80 S. Franklin Street. Please see the schedule below to determine available pick-up days and times.
- **MARCH 1:** Beginning March 1, 2016, recycling will be collected from the new 32-gallon Waste Management carts, any plastic water-tight can or bin with a lid that is less than 33 gallons in size, or residents' existing bins. No bags of any kind can be used for recycling.

New wheeled 32-gallon carts will be available for residents to pick up at the Borough Utility Service Center, 80 S. Franklin Street, as follows:

In the world of recycling, small steps equal big change. This is especially true when it comes to the things you place in your recycling and we need the right things ending up in the recycling to truly make a difference.

So next time you go to put something in your recycling, follow these three rules.



Recycle all empty plastic bottles, cans and paper.



Keep foods and liquids out of the recycling.



Keep recyclables loose and not bagged in plastic bags. Take plastic bags back to your local grocer.

These three steps may seem like small acts in themselves, but they have a big impact. If unrecyclable household items, such as hoses or bowling balls, make it into the recycling, or items are wet and dirty, the entire load can become garbage and end up in a landfill. Should you run into any trouble along the way, remember the rule of thumb: when in doubt, leave it out.

all other days will be picked up one day later
throughout the week.



Thursday, November 24

Collection Day will be Friday November 25
Friday November 25 Collection Day will be
Saturday November 26



Sunday, December 25

All collection days remain the same.
No Change.

Sanitation Department Refuse Collection Schedule 2016

In Chambersburg, refuse & recycling is collected from registered customers by voting ward (with one exception):

Day of the Week	Ward
Monday	1st Ward: If you vote at St Paul United Methodist Church or the Park Avenue United Methodist Church
Tuesday	2nd Ward: If you vote at the CASD District Offices on Stanley Avenue
Wednesday	3rd Ward: If you vote at the Eugene C. Clark Recreation Center Section One: All of the 3 rd Ward EXCEPT those 3 rd Ward addresses west of Water St., Hollywell Ave to Dump Rd. or in the Franklin County Housing Authority neighborhood
Thursday	3rd Ward: If you vote at the Eugene C. Clark Recreation Center Section Two: ONLY those 3 rd Ward addresses west of Water St., Hollywell Ave to Dump Rd. or in the Franklin County Housing Authority neighborhood
Thursday	4th Ward: If you vote at the First Lutheran Church, West Washington St. Or the Falling Spring Presbyterian Church
Friday	5th Ward: If you vote at the Chambersburg Bible Church or the First Baptist Church

If you have any question about your Ward, please call the Borough offices.

Holiday Collection Schedule

The Borough of Chambersburg will observe the following holidays **ONLY** which will affect your collection schedule **unless otherwise notified by the Borough by post card: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas.**

If the holiday falls on:

- Monday your collection day will be Tuesday
- Tuesday your collection day will be Wednesday
- Wednesday your collection day will be Thursday
- Thursday your collection day will be Friday
- Friday your collection day will be Saturday

Because of the extension of time between collections you will be permitted four (4) refuse receptacles instead of the usual three (3) for the **first collection only immediately following the holiday.**

**32 GALLON CONTAINER IS LARGEST PERMITTED FOR REFUSE or RECYCLING.
PLEASE DO NOT SET REFUSE OUT MORE THAN 24 HOURS BEFORE PICKUP.**

Bulky waste: never place bulky waste curbside. There will be a drop off day schedule. Violators will pay a fee.

Electronic waste: never place electronics curbside. Electronics will also be accepted on Bulky Waste drop off days.

Green yard waste: other than grass clippings, never place green yard waste in trash. Use the Yard Waste drop off.

Fall leaves: sweep or rake non-trash leaves into the gutter or curblin and the Borough will come by and collect.

Christmas trees: the Borough collects Christmas trees without glitter or ornaments curbside after New Years.
