Chambersburg Police Chief Ron Camacho and I would like to invite all adults who either live or work in the Borough of Chambersburg to attend our brand new Citizen's Police Academy. It is actually a nation-wide program designed to help the public learn what goes on in their local police departments.

Citizen's Police Academy is free but all applicants must be at least 18 years old, either live or work in the Borough of Chambersburg, and submit an application.
