2026 Fall Electronic Waste Drop-Off Days AND Bulky Items Drop-Off Days (Two Separate Events) for Borough Residents Only

The Borough of Chambersburg will once again accept bulky items and electronic waste items at the Borough Farm located off Dump Road, at 725 Hollywell Ave. Chambersburg, Pa. 17201

ELECTRONIC WASTE ITEMS will be collected **September 2nd through September 5th**, from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. Wednesday from 8:00 AM to 6:00PM.

BULKY ITEMS will be collected at this location **September 14th through September 19th**, from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. Wednesday from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM.

Please do NOT bring e-waste to the bulky item collection days or bulky items to e-waste collection days; as they cannot be accepted during the incorrect periods.

All Borough residents who take advantage of this opportunity to dispose of their bulky items or e-waste will be required to provide photo identification with address (such as a driver's license) prior to entering the facility. Additionally, anyone contracted to haul bulky items on behalf of a Borough resident will be required to provide the name, address, phone number, and a copy of the utility bill of the resident whose bulky items are being hauled.

CHAMBERSBURG will only accept two (2) pieces of electronic waste (e-waste) from each household during the e-waste collection event. Peripherals and accessories do not count towards the two-item limit. For example, a desktop computer includes the keyboard, mouse, and monitor all as one item.

Chambersburg residents may NOT place bulky or electronic items curbside for collection: dumping of these items on public property, including streets, alleys, and sidewalks is always prohibited. To ensure that these items are collected efficiently, Town Council has switched to allowing the free drop off of these items at the Borough Farm. Dumping on private property (rather than sidewalks, streets, and alleys) is a Code Enforcement offense. Trash in someone's back yard or front porch may be a violation of the Property Maintenance Code. If you want to file a complaint regarding trash on private property, call the Borough's 24/7 Customer Service Center at (717) 263-4111.

Please call the Public Works Office at 261-3213, Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM with any questions pertaining to the bulky item or e-waste drop-off program.

This service is provided to Chambersburg Borough residential trash customers only. **COMMERCIAL ENTERPRISES ARE PROHIBITED** from participating in this program.

This is a free service for Chambersburg Borough residential trash customers only and is supported by the Borough's Sanitation Department.

There are no coupons needed this year, just bring valid photo identification.

These two events are for bulky items and electronic waste ONLY. **No construction debris will be accepted: no bricks, no drywall, no cinder blocks, no floor or ceiling tiles, no construction wood or anything that can fit into a garbage bag.**

No green yard waste will be accepted: all green yard waste should be taken to the Green Yard Waste recycling center at 491 W. Commerce Street in Hamilton Township. A Borough Green Yard Waste card is required for drop-off. Cards are available at City Hall during regular business hours.

**The following are Electronic Waste Items
(for drop-off from September 2nd
through September 5th ONLY):**

Devices such as televisions, desktop computers, laptop computers, computer monitors, computer peripherals, DVD Players, video tape recorders, stereo equipment, telephone equipment, and any other “covered” electronic device.

Computer peripherals, such as a mouse, do not count against the two-item limit.

This is the ONLY e-waste recycling event planned for 2026, so don't miss it!
