

Notice is hereby given by the Town Council of the Borough of Chambersburg, Franklin County, Pennsylvania that Town Council will consider the proposed Ordinance for adoption at the regularly scheduled public meeting of the Borough of Chambersburg on March 14, 2022, at 7:00 p.m. The Ordinance is as follows:

ORDINANCE NUMBER 2022 – ____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CHAMBERSBURG,
FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING THE
CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF CHAMBERSBURG AT
CHAPTER 286, ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, IN
ORDER TO ESTABLISH RULES ASSOCIATED WITH ON-
STREET PARKING IN FRONT OF CLUSTER MAILBOXES IN
PROGRESS VILLAGE

WHEREAS, the Borough Code, 8 Pa. C.S. §§ 101, *et seq.*, in section 1202(31), authorizes the Borough of Chambersburg (the “Borough”) to regulate the use of parking lots, regulate parking, and impose fines and fees for violations of any law or ordinance regulating parking, 8 Pa. C.S. § 1202(31); and

WHEREAS, Section 1202(4) of the Borough Code authorizes the Borough to prohibit and remove nuisances on public or private grounds, including obstructions or nuisances in the streets of the Borough, to remove said obstructions or nuisances, and to collect the cost and a penalty for said removal, 8 Pa. C.S. § 1202(4); and

WHEREAS, Section 1202(5) of the Borough Code authorizes the Borough to make regulations as may be necessary for the health, safety, welfare, cleanliness and beauty, and convenience and comfort of the Borough, 8 Pa. C.S. § 1202(5); and

WHEREAS, the Chambersburg Police Department has requested clarification of rules and regulations associated with on-street parking in front of cluster mailboxes in Progress Village; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Chambersburg regularly and routinely exercises its police powers, for the health and safety of the community, to necessarily limit, on a temporary basis, on-street parking, in specific zones and areas, in order to maintain properly the public right-of-way and utilities.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Mayor and Town Council of the Borough of Chambersburg, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and it is enacted and ordained, as follows:

SECTION 1. The contents of CHAPTER 286, Article III, of the Code of the Borough of Chambersburg, entitled "Parking Regulations", are hereby amended by adding the following regulations to an existing list.

Add the following to the existing list under:

Article III, Parking Regulations

§ 286-29 Parking prohibited in specific locations certain days and hours.

Parking shall be prohibited in the following locations at all times on the days and between the hours hereby indicated:

SECTION 2. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any of its sections, clauses or sentences shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional, such provision shall not affect or impair any other sections, clauses or sentences of the same.

SECTION 3. Repealer. All provisions of previous ordinances of the Borough of Chambersburg, which are contrary to this Ordinance, are expressly repealed.

SECTION 4. Effective date. The provisions of this ordinance shall take effective immediately.
