- CAP-County wide Action Plan - Franklin County's official strategy to satisfy PA State WIP 3 nutrient reduction requirements (43 PA Counties required to have a CAP)
- CWFC Clean Water for Franklin County Franklin County Conservation District's (FCCD) clean water initiative to aid in meeting CAP requirements
- BMP Best Management Practices tools/conservation practices that can help to benefit soil health, water resources, and even the operation

BY THE END OF 2025. FRANKLIN COUNTY IS TASKED BY THE CAP TO REDUCE:

~1.3 million pounds of Nitrogen (lbsN) ~70,000 pounds of Phosphorus (lbsP)

BECAUSE: Excess nutrients and sediment are harmful to aquatic life.
