## **Chambersburg's Borough Manager Receives National Public Service Honor**

**CHAMBERSBURG, PA** — Jeffrey Stonehill, Borough Manager and Director of Utilities for the Borough of Chambersburg, Pennsylvania, has been selected as one of America's 250 Public Service Champions by the National Academy of Public Administration as part of the Local Gov 250 initiative; in celebration of the 250<sup>th</sup> birthday of the U.S.A.

The national recognition honors public servants who have made exceptional contributions to their communities as the United States prepares to celebrate its 250th anniversary.

Stonehill was selected from more than 350 nominees across the country and is among 250 individuals recognized for their leadership, dedication to public service, and positive impact on local communities.

Town Council President Bill Everly praised Stonehill's leadership and the impact of his work in Chambersburg.

"Having been here almost 17 years, Jeffrey has played a key role in advancing important initiatives that strengthen our community," Everly said. "His leadership in the redevelopment of this community, expansion and rehabilitation of our utility systems, and keeping Chambersburg's utility rates the lowest in Pennsylvania, has been demonstrated in efforts like a new utility projects like our solar and landfill gas generating systems, the Aquatic Center, the new Police Station, the Public Works Campus project, and revitalization of our downtown, which together strengthen the Borough's infrastructure and planning for economic development, and improvements in customer-focused services for residents and businesses for the next Century."

Chambersburg is the only community in Pennsylvania to operate water, wastewater, natural gas, and electric utilities.

Local Gov 250 is a national effort led by local governments and government associations to highlight the role of local government and recognize the impact public servants have on their communities.

Stonehill will be honored along with other award recipients during the 250 Public Service Champions Celebration on May 12 in Philadelphia, held in conjunction with the ICMA Reimagining Government Conference.
