

PUBLIC NOTICE - The following proposed ordinance of the Borough of Chambersburg will be brought up for enactment within not less than 7 days or more than 60 days after the date of this notice. A public meeting is scheduled for Monday, February 13, 2023 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers, 100 South Second Street, Chambersburg, PA to consider enactment of the following:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF CHAMBERSBURG CHAPTER 286 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC TO IN ORDER TO REVISE RULES ASSOCIATED WITH ON-STREET METERED PARKING

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Town Council of the Borough of Chambersburg, as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Article IV, Parking Regulations, §286-39, Parking meter zones established, of the Code of the Borough of Chambersburg, Council herein ratifies the elimination of two metered on-street parking spaces on the north side of East King Street located within the North Main Street and North Second Street parking meter zone, as directed by the Borough Manager and recommended by the Parking, Traffic, and Street Lights Committee.

SECTION 2. The following shall be **AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:** Article III, Parking Regulations, § 286-25, Parking prohibited at all times in certain locations:

<u>Highway</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>
King Street	South	For a distance of 18 feet east of the end of the bridge over the Conococheague Creek to Hood Street between the east end of the bridge over the Falling Spring Branch and Main Street for a distance of 44 feet east of Main Street towards Central Avenue for a distance of 6 feet west of Central Avenue to Second Street under the Railroad Highline
King Street	South	<u>The bridge over the Conococheague Creek and Hood Street</u>
King Street	South	<u>The bridge over the Conococheague Creek for 85 feet east</u>
King Street	South	Pioneer Alley and N. Second Street
King Street	South	Main Street and a point approximately 50 feet east thereof
King Street	South	<u>Main Street and N. Second Street</u>
King Street	South	<u>N. Second Street for a distance of 44 feet east</u>
King Street	South	<u>Harrison Alley and N. Third Street</u>
King Street	South	<u>From the east curbline of North Third Street east for 70 feet to the sign adjacent to the Gospel Chapel</u>

Please note that underline is added and ~~strikethrough~~ is deleted.

SECTION 3. Effective date. The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective in accord with law.
