Responsible Alcohol Management Program (RAMP)



Act 141 of 2000 established the Responsible Alcohol Management Program (RAMP), a voluntary certification consisting of four program prerequisites - Owner/Manager Training, Server/Seller Training, New Employee Orientation and Signage - that upon successful completion, enable licensees to apply for RAMP certification for approval by the PLCB.

RAMP makes <u>training</u> and resources available to licensees and their employees, so that they may understand and employ responsible alcohol management practices.

RAMP certification can be mandated under the following circumstances:

- For any licensee who has been found guilty by an Administrative Law Judge of sales to minors or visibly intoxicated persons
- As part of a conditional licensing agreement (CLA)
- Prior to obtaining a wine expanded permit

Licensees are encouraged to explore and complete the <u>RAMP certification</u>, which is designed to assist licensees in educating new hires, current employees and themselves in legal and responsible alcohol service.

In Chambersburg, liquor providers are required to be RAMP certified.
